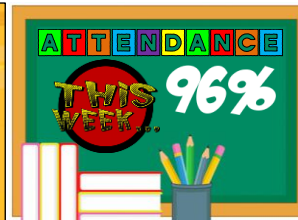


# ASH GREEN WEEKLY NEWS

Thank you to all parents and carers who joined us for our Celebration Assemblies this morning.

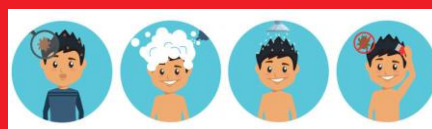
