### NEU Industrial Action

Next Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February sees the first planned day of strike action by the National Education Union. On that day, we have a small number of teachers who will support that strike action and we support their right to take that decision. We are also aware of our responsibility to you- the community- to remain open where possible for our children. So, on that day (Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup>) all children will be able to attend school. However, in some classes- we cannot identify those classes- there will be a different day planned with the curriculum not delivered and class teachers possibly not available. This will cause disruption to learning but we are keen that we support striking colleagues by not attempting to replicate learning but also support families in that children will be cared for, occupied with activities and fed.

We understand that this may mean some children may not attend on that day. We particularly understand that children who struggle with change may not be comfortable that day and are not in. We also understand that children under mandatory school age- those in Nursery or Just 3 may not attend on this 'different' day. All we ask is that any parents and carers who are keeping children off that day get in touch with school to let us know.

Thank you for your ongoing support and also your understanding that we support colleagues who are taking this decision whilst also balancing that with our support for you the community. Breakfast Club and After School Club will run that day but no teacher-led clubs.



We have spaces at our fantastic After School Club. It runs each night at the Upper Site, 3:15-5:45. Any Lower Site children are transported up by minibus. The children have a healthy tea, playgames and take part in art, craft and drama activities as well as having opportunities to use technology items too. It's a very friendly and safe space.
