Please also remember that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for a Universal Free School Meal. We have a number of children who are eligible for Free School Meals who are bringing packed lunches: help us to help you by ensuring your children take up the school meal option. And remember, our paid meals - at only £1.60 - are cheaper than packed lunches can be put together. We would love to see even more of our children eating school lunches!
